Expert discussed the following topics:

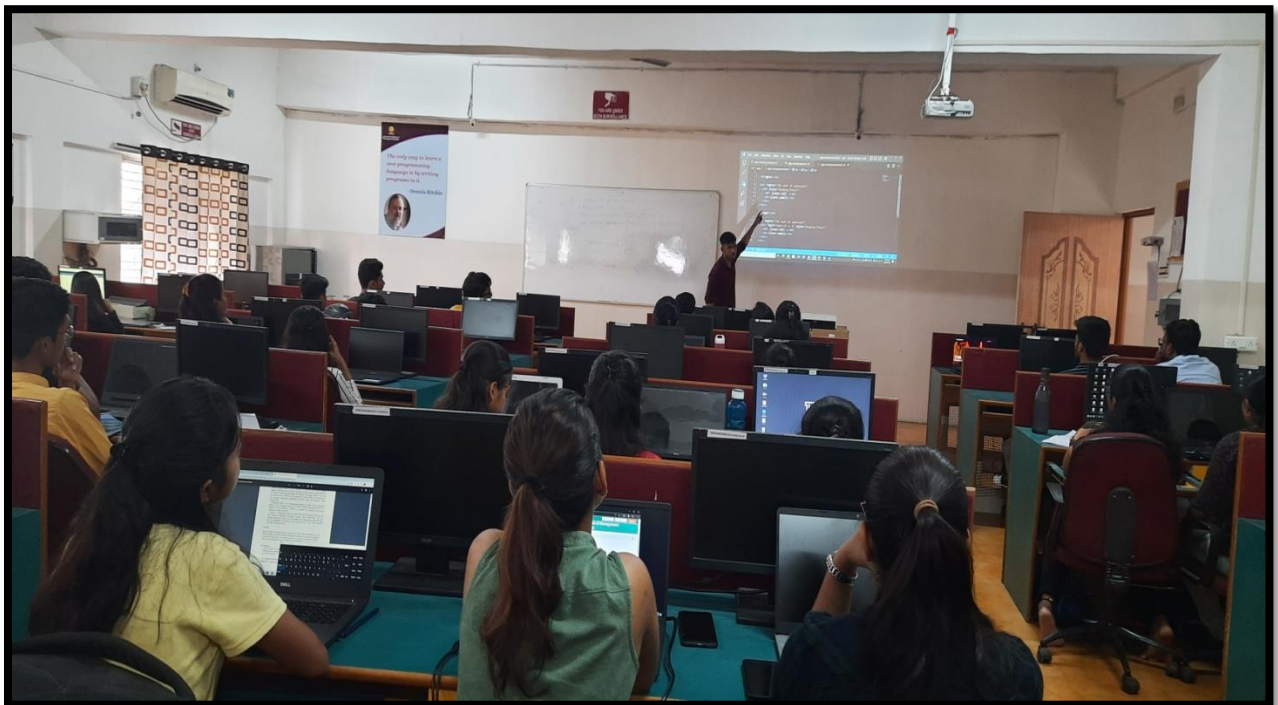
1. Type Script
