The timing of the session was between 12 noon to 4:00 p.m.

In the introductory session Mrs. Swasti Khandale highlighted the Importance of Soft skills in today's global market.

She gave a brief introduction about the Soft skills or social skills (also called non-technical skills) are those personal values and interpersonal skills that determine a person's ability to work well with others in a project team.

She also highlighted that Soft skills are needed to deal with the external world and to work in a collaborative manner with one's colleagues. These skills include effective communication, leadership, and teamwork skills; demonstrating problem solving abilities, initiative, and motivation skills; displaying honesty and strong

Work ethics.

She also highlighted the Importance of Soft skills, as it plays a vital role for academic and professional success; they help us excel in the workplace and their importance cannot be denied in the emerging information or knowledge society. Soft skills are needed to deal with the external world and to work in a collaborative manner with one's colleagues.

She briefly explained the purpose of Soft Skills these may include the following:

- Communication skills
- Listening skills
- Presentation skills
- Interpersonal skills
- Team skills

- Leadership skills
- Etiquette
- Cross-cultural skills
- Language skills, etc.

She stressed the need for developing soft skills needs practice. These are acquired and experienced on the spot. Soft skills cannot be acquired by merely reading textbooks. The soft skills we gain equip us to excel in our academic/professional life and in our personal life. **It is a continuous learning process.**
