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
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Day 1: 27th December 2021: Familiarization Session [Both MBA & MCA]



Day 5: 31st December 2021: Group Discussion & Scholarship Eligibility




As per Dept. of Higher Education, Govt. of Maharashtra, financial help as


meditation, exercise and prayer. This interesting session was attended by freshers of both MBA and MCA.








Major Amol Mali, DGM; L&T, Pune, two such role models on this eventful day. The highlighting points of the day are as follows.

Day 11: 8th January 2022: Lectures by Expert Professionals


Expert professional are valuable elements of a developed society by virtue of their Knowledge, Experience, Adaptability and Judgment. This day was very special for the

online lecture by three expert




