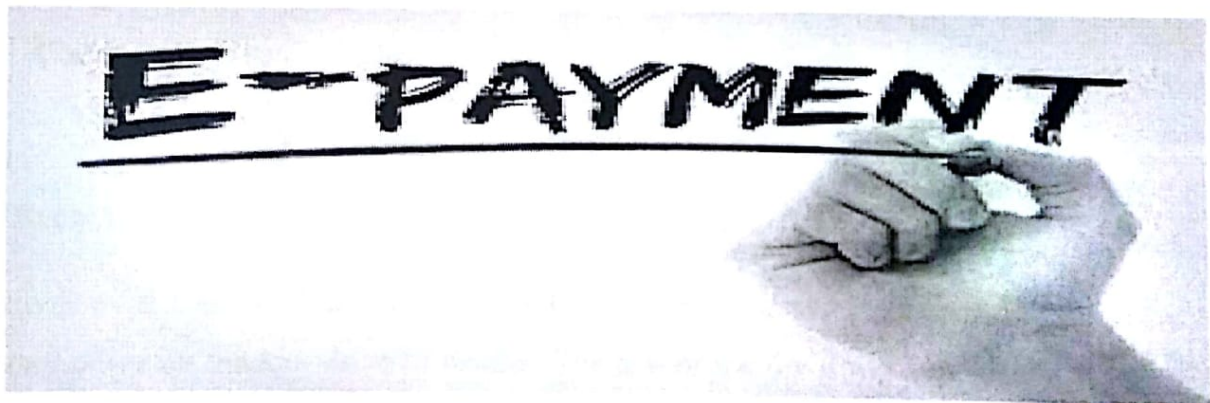

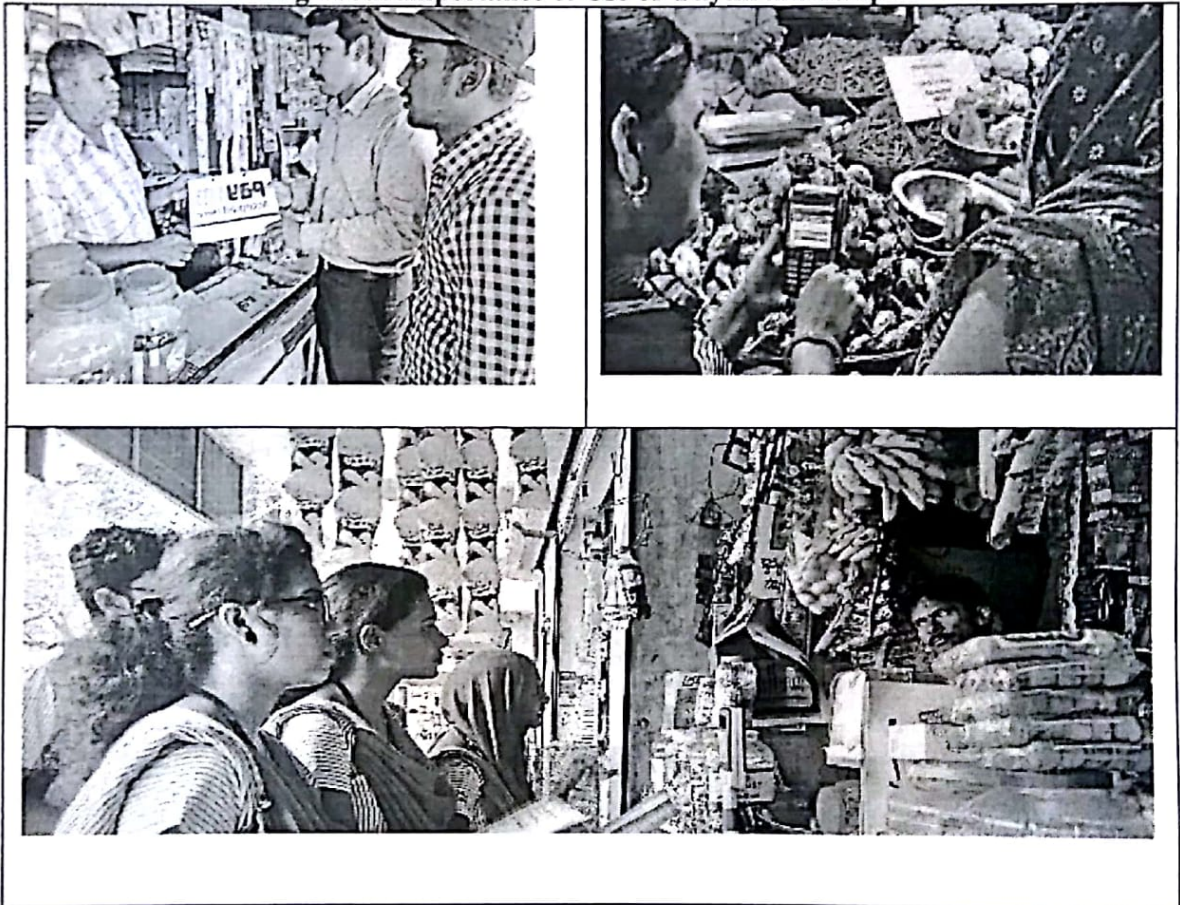
REAL VALUE Consultants Pvt. Ltd. is a company which is working in financial sector for quite some time now & their guidance was quite valuable in this event.

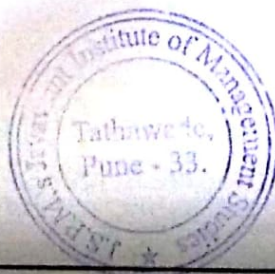
**Team Members telling about Importance & Use of Paytm and swap machine**

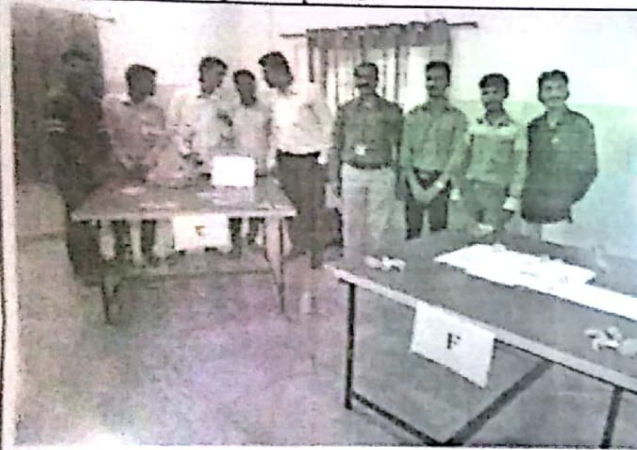
