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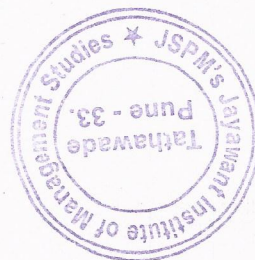

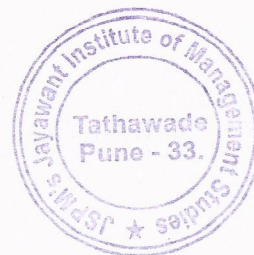
In the morning 9:15 AM, our team reached Durga Hills. After the initial introduction amongst the students and Avirat employees, we proceeded to the main agenda.

Brief Report:

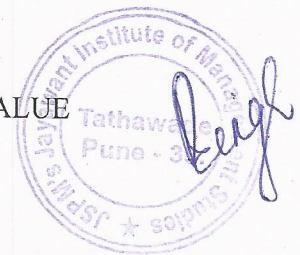

We visited the Temple of Shiva which is located on top of the fort where everyone offered prayers, after which everyone had their lunch.

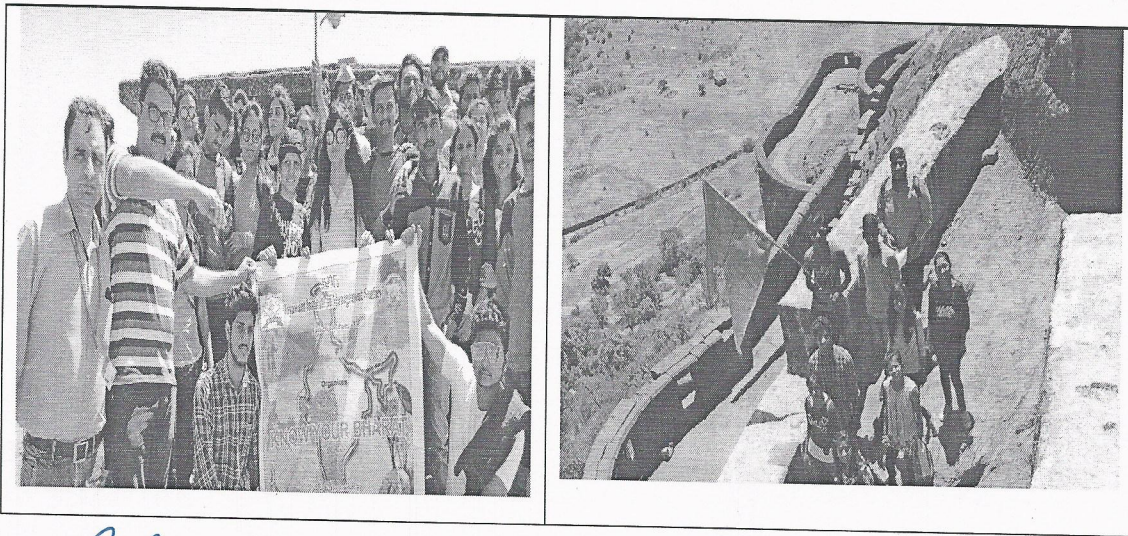


The Bus reached the Institute @ 4.00 p.m.

The program had exceeded in achieving the desired objectives:

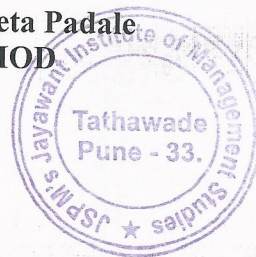
1. By taking students to such a place which has rich historical heritage and making them aware about the same.

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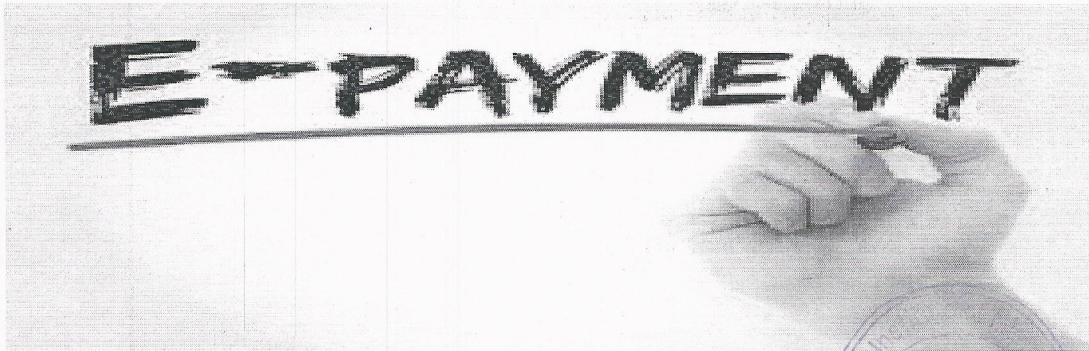

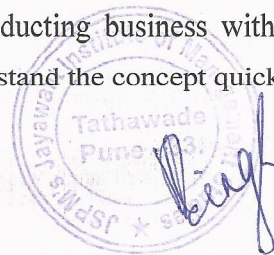
Brief Report:

We contacted and explained the various modes/channels for conducting business without cash. Demo was given to traders and vendors which helped them to understand the concept quickly.

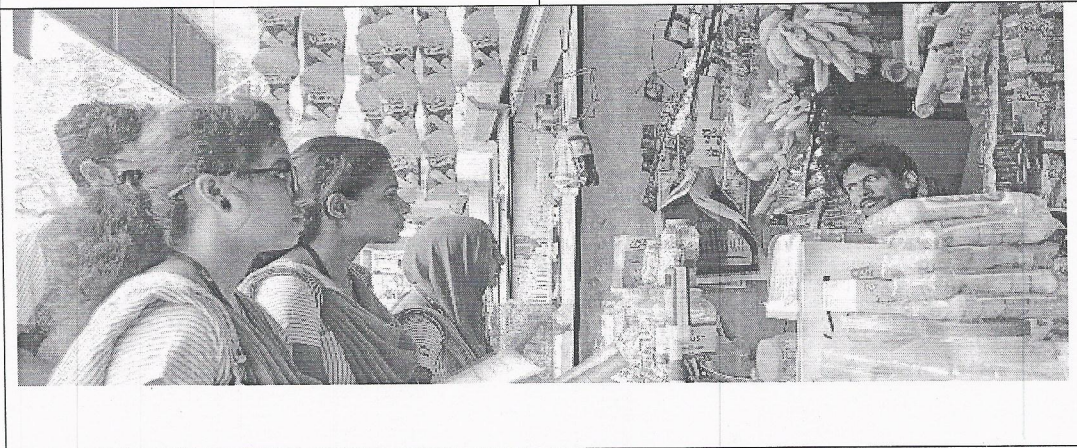
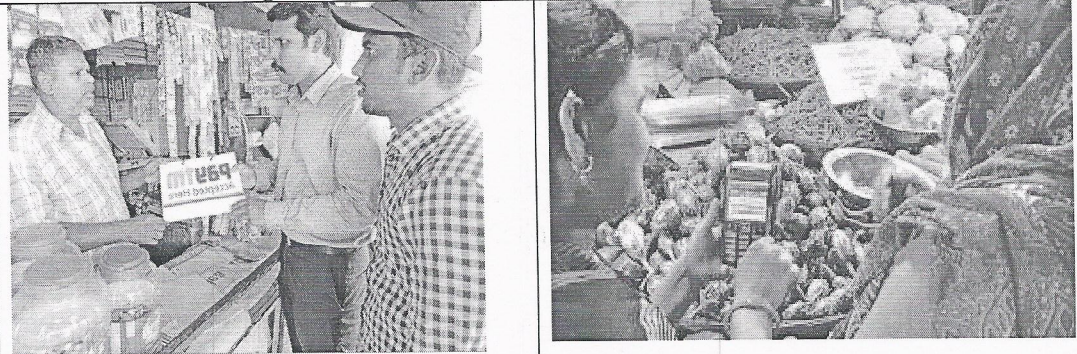

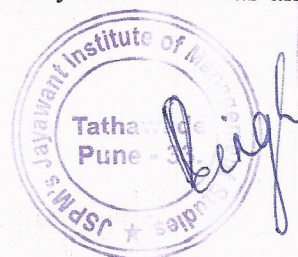
Program Objective: 1) To create awareness about ill-effects of Addictions (viz. Smoking, Drugs, Drinking Alcohol etc).

The program started with the introduction of the Guests and felicitation of the Guests by Dr. Priyanka Singh (Director) & Dr. Bipin Bankar (HoD- MBA). Students from JIMS, Rajarshi Shahu College of Engineering, Rajarshi Shahu College of Pharmacy and Research, Rajarshi Shahu College of Education as well as DIMR were present to listen and get motivated from the two times Guinness Book record holder Mr. Deshmukh and also from other speakers.

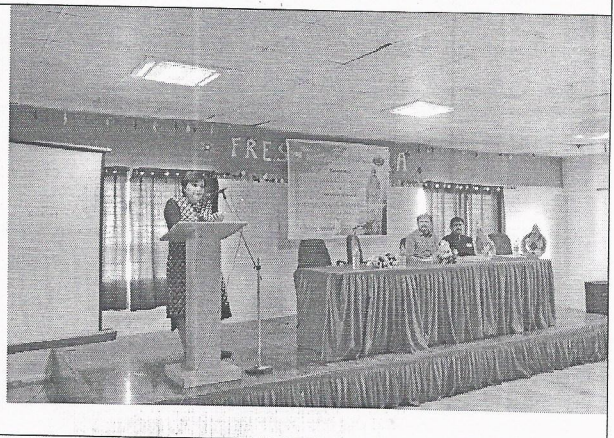
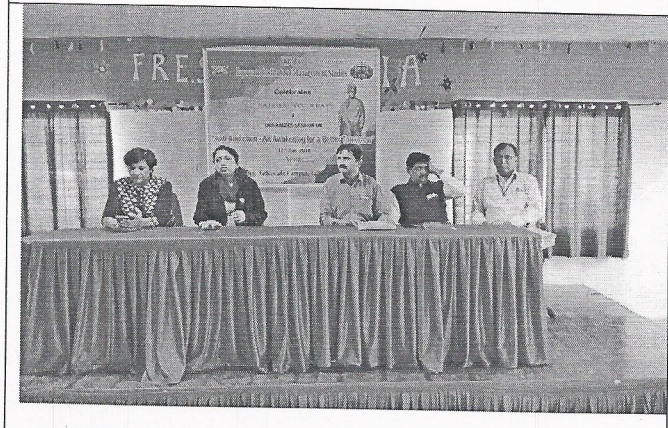
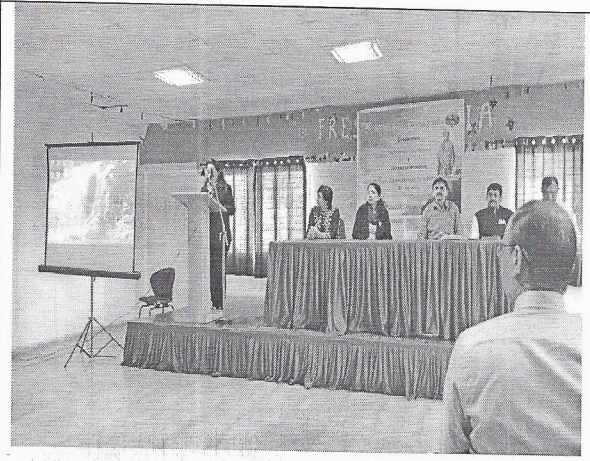
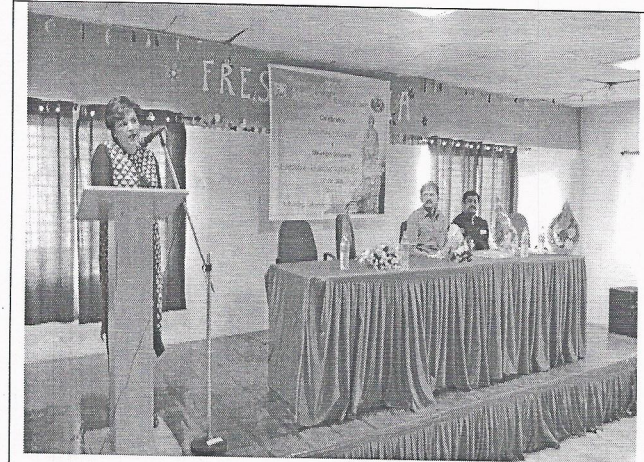
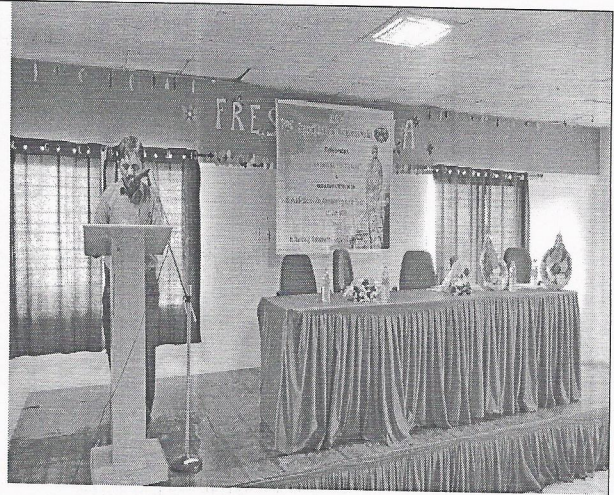
To get rid of these addictions he suggested that, students to exercise on a daily basis and to meditate.



The participants then went on to gain some hands on experience.






About Event

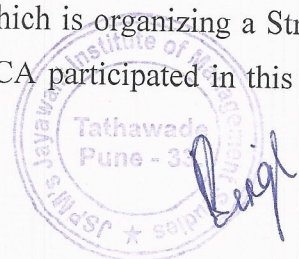
Head Injuries in a Road Accident are the most notable cause of deaths. These can be avoided to a large extent by wearing Helmets however it is a common thing in India not to wear Helmet.

Around the World there are many countries that have made laws in this regard. In India, some cities and states have made it compulsory, but much more remains to be done. More than making laws it is important to make people and in particular Youth of today aware that wearing Helmet is the need of the hour. In Pune the traffic is many times quite chaotic and hazardous.

Considering this we decided to educate and advocate the importance of wearing Helmets to the students of our Campus, where large number of students commute and drive a two-wheeler. Many of them do not wear helmets.

The event was organized in the Tathawade Campus which houses Rajarshi Shahu College of Engineering, Rajarshi Shahu College of Pharmacy and Research, Engineering, Rajarshi Shahu College of Education, Jayawant institute of Pharmacy (all together nearly 4000 students). Apart from students there are at least 1000 teaching, non-teaching and support staff working in this campus.

We adopted a novel and innovative idea to propagate our suggestion, which is organizing a Street Play with the theme of "Helmet Please". In all 32 students from MBA & MCA participated in this activity.



They formed 6 different groups and presented the skit on importance of Wearing Helmet and Saving Life. 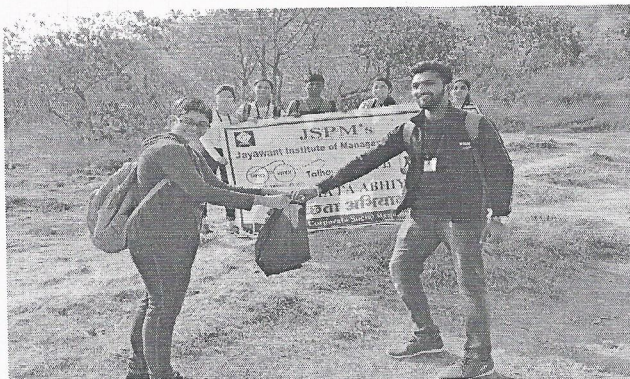
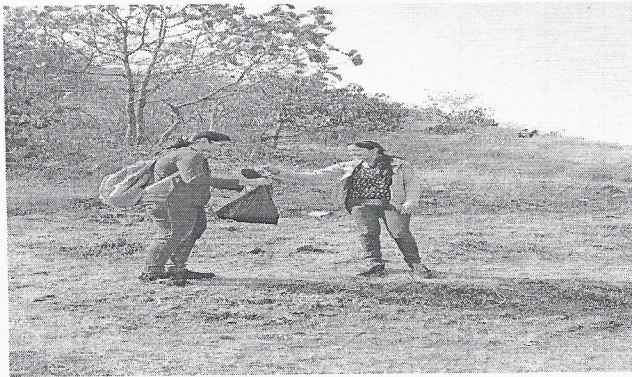
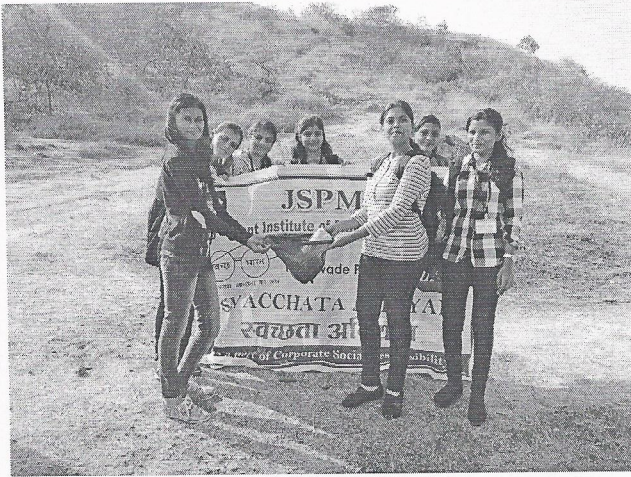
After reaching the top we took some rest and then proceeded to offer our prayers to Lord Shivs.

The objective being fulfilled we started our return journey and reached the college at 12.30 hours.





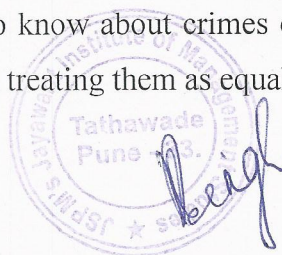
After this the participants started showcasing the films to the judges and the audience.

After watching all the films Judges evaluated and announced the winners. They gave away the prizes to them.


The event was coordinated by Prof. Kamlesh Meshram. The event concluded with vote of thanks.

Report:

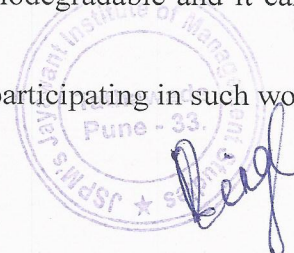
Shri Ganesh, the elephant-headed son of Lord Shiva and Parvati is widely worshiped as the god of wisdom and prosperity. He is worshiped first before any auspicious work. Shri Ganesh Festival is celebrated all over India and it is the main festival of Maharashtra. Traditionally, the Ganesh sculptors make idols of and after worshiping it in the festival it is returned back to the Earth by immersing it in a nearby water body. Due to use of Plaster of Paris and some non-degradable elements, environment is getting effected. The most serious impact of the Shri Ganesh festival on the natural environment is, that the immersion Plaster of Paris getting into rivers and the water bodies. The toxic waste kills plant and animal life in the water. After the submerging of Ganesh idols, non-degradable substances of idols are appearing at the shore of lakes and sea. To minimize the impact on environment, we wanted to promote Eco-friendly Shri Ganesh celebration campaign.

Our Institute along with Dnyansagar Institute of Management and Research (DIMR) decided to educate those people who come for Ganesh Immersion on river. In all 24 students and 1 faculty member from our Institute and 6 students from DIMR, went to nearby Pavana River Ghat where Water Tanks were already placed by the Government Officials. The students then started persuading people to use water tanks to immerse their Ganesh Idol instead of immersing it in the river. Many a times Ganesha may leave everyone's home after the festivities, but the partially dissolved idols are found floating in the water bodies, which is disrespectful to the Lord Ganesha.

They were counseled them about the adverse effects of immersing the Ganesh Idol in the River water which causes many environmental issues like water pollution thereby causing various diseases.

Also the people who were having Ganesh Idols, made from traditional materials, were informed about eco friendly Ganesh Idols available in the market which cause lesser or no environmental issues. These Eco-Friendly Ganesh idols are completely biodegradable and it can be immersed even in a bucket of water at home.

People were quite happy that college students are actively participating in such worthy cause.



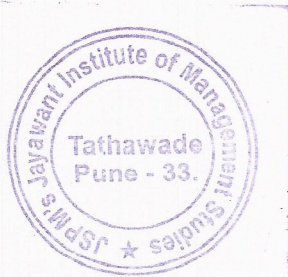
After spending nearly 3 hours we returned from the Ghat having achieved our objective.

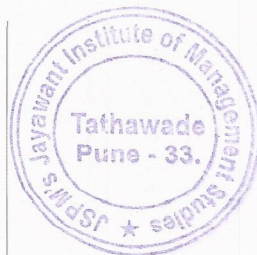
The Youth Day was celebrated on 12th Jan.2016 in memory of Swami Vivekananda whose Birth Anniversary is celebrated on this day.



A street play was performed by our students for depicting the ill effects of consuming tobacco.

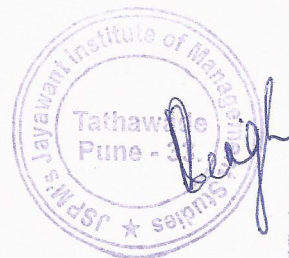
After some time people started gathering near us and we started interacting with them. Slowly the topic was taken to chewing of Tobacco and the ill effects of it.

We reached the school at around 9.30 am. The school children from Class I to Class IV were then assembled in the school ground where the session took place. Around 125 students were gathered in the school ground.

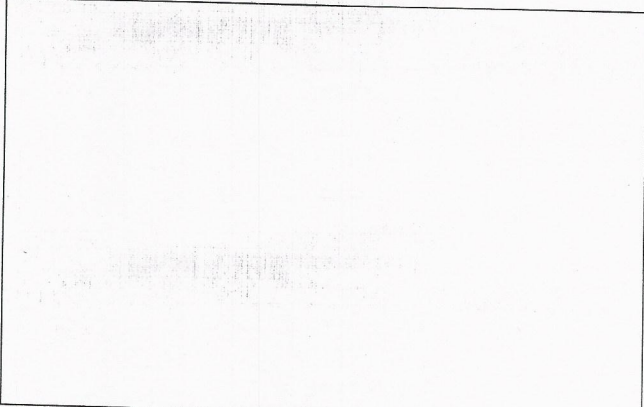
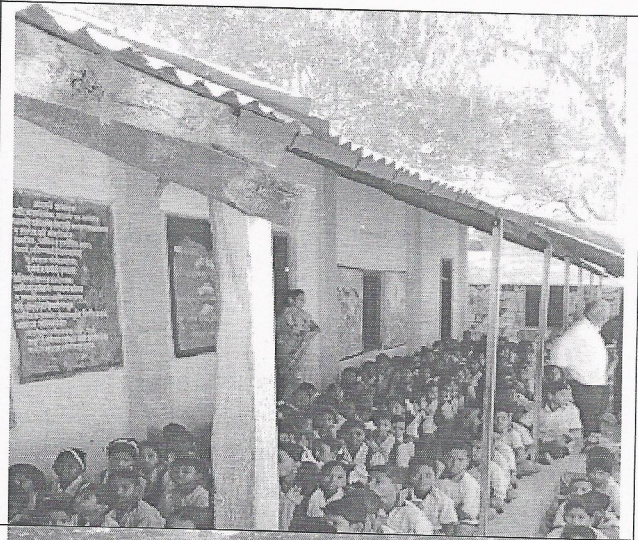
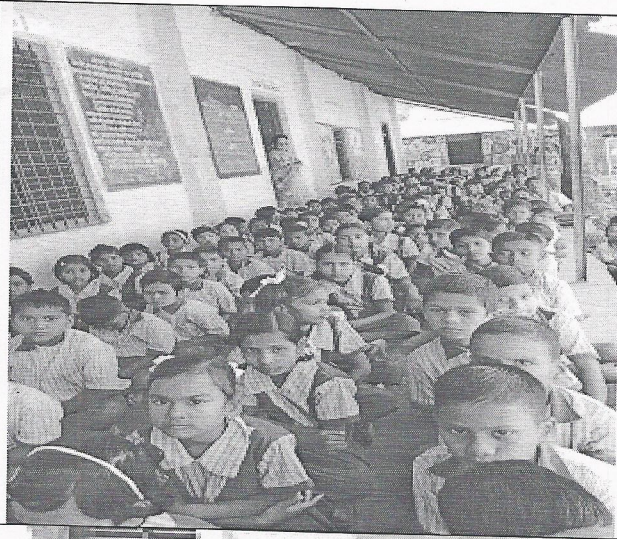

Students enthusiastically participated in the program. Students have learned many environment management lessons with actual field training. They planted and watered around 50 plants.


The program ended with vote of thanks proposed by Prof. Kumar Pawar. We returned to college by 3:00 PM.

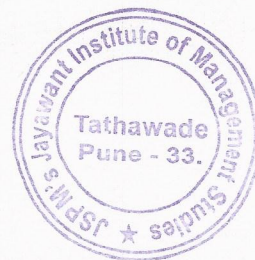

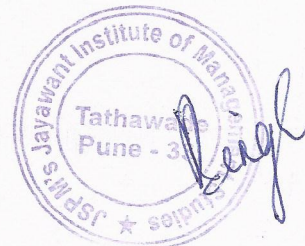

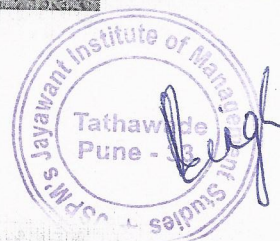

SHORT DESCRIPTION

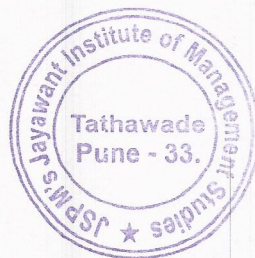



Brief report:

According to a report - Waste management rules in India are based on the principles of "sustainable development", "precaution" and "polluter pays". These principles mandate municipalities and commercial establishments to act in an environmentally accountable and responsible manner—restoring balance, if their actions disrupt it.


Our country is passing through a phase of rapid urbanization and with this the nation faces a massive waste management challenge. It is estimated that over 377 million urban people live in 7,935 towns and cities and generate 62 million tons of municipal solid waste per annum. Only 43 million tons (MT) of the waste is collected, 11.9 MT is treated and 31 MT is dumped in landfill sites. The key to efficient and successful waste management system is to ensure proper segregation of waste at source.

To solve this problem we as a responsible educational institute and a sensible corporate citizen we decided to contribute by whatever little means we could and hence we decided to approach Housing Society near our institute and educate them about the importance of Proper Segregation of Household Waste into Wet and Dry Waste.

We approached Mangaltirth Co-operative Housing Society Ltd. and received a positive response from them.

The Team went to this society on 2nd February 2014 (Sunday) at around 9 am, since it was informed to us that on Sunday maximum number of members would be available.

Initially the students explained to the members that waste segregation basically means keeping wet and dry wastes separately; so that dry can be recycled and wet waste can be composted. They explained why segregation needs to be done- so that different processes- composting, recycling, incineration can be applied to different kinds of waste. Examples of different kinds of dry waste were given to them.



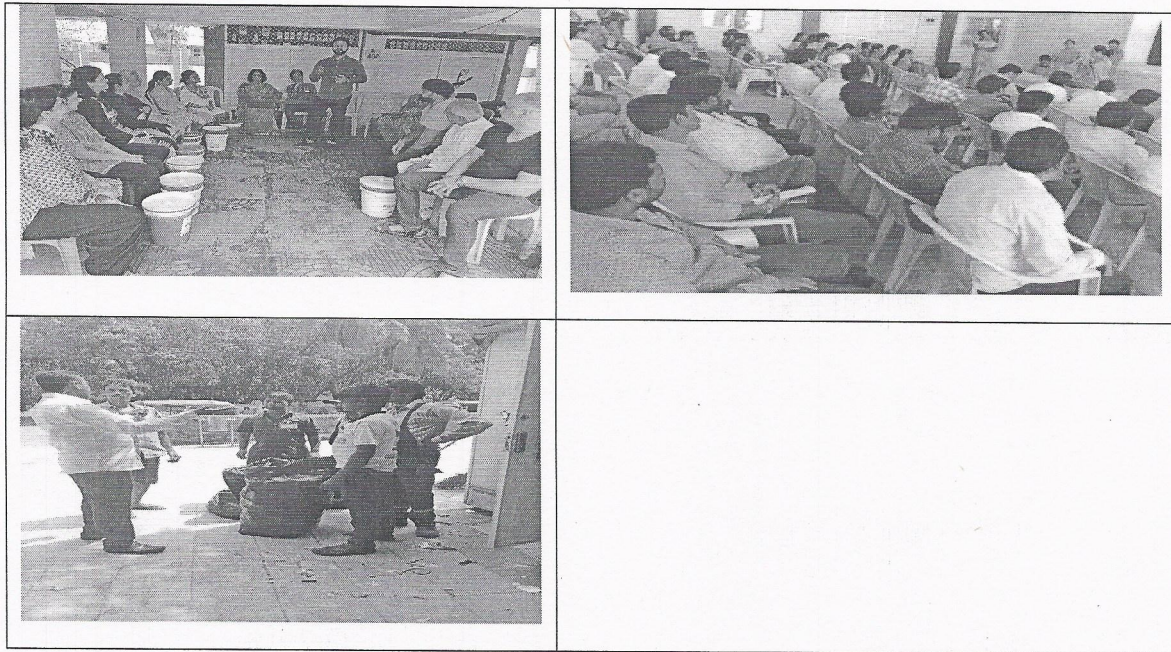
Further it was suggested that how to separate the waste material viz. keeping separate containers for dry and wet waste in the kitchen, keeping two bags for dry waste collection- paper and plastic , for the rest of the household waste etc.

We requested them to explain waste segregation to their family members and staff in the society building to also understand this important issue.

We also requested them that if they are in possession of old clothes, shoes, toys etc and if they are still in usable condition, they should be given to some organization that collects them. We offered them our services in case they require it in future.

The suggestions were well accepted by the society members and they appreciated the students for being involved in such a noble cause.

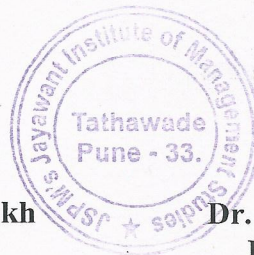

Later it was followed with small games like tug of war, antakshari and mimicry amongst the kids and the volunteers. There was also a motivational story telling session for the children.

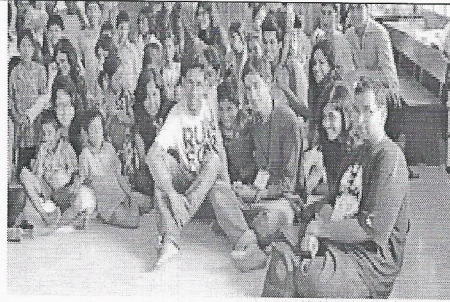
The overall session was very overwhelming and the kids enjoyed a lot.
