The session was ended with vote of thanks by Prof. Aakash Sane of MBA Department.



> To be aware about the essential and fundamental aspects of object oriented analysis and design, in terms of "how to use" it for the purpose of specifying and developing software.

A one day workshop on UML Designing was conducted on 8th August 2015, Saturday at JSPM's JIMS. The event started at 9:00 a.m. on Saturday and the speaker for the workshop was Mr. Kamal Pandey (Software Engineer, HCL Technologies).

The event started with a brief introduction about the speaker which was given by Prof. Aditya Katkar. Mr. Kamal Pandey started his session with a brief introduction about OOPS. In which he mentioned about the object oriented approach and its use.

He also gave some important concepts regarding the principles of Object-oriented Technology-

- > Abstraction- Focus only on essentials, and only on those aspects needed in the given context.
- > Encapsulation- To hide details of structure and implementation.
- > Modularity- Decomposition of system into smaller and more manageable parts.
- ➤ Hierarchy- A ranking or ordering of abstractions on the basis of their complexity and responsibility. It includes Object Hierarchy and Inheritance Hierarchy.
- > Polymorphism-It is the ability to hide multiple implementations behind a single interface.

After the introduction about object oriented technology he started with the Use Case Diagram and its uses in which he mentioned the functionality of a system by using Actors and Use Cases. A continuation session on **UML modeling** was conducted in which he focused on the following topics

- > Sequence Diagram-A sequence diagram describes interactions among classes in terms of an "exchange of message over time". Sequence Diagrams provide a better correlation between the "dynamic view" of the system and "static view" held in Class Diagram.
- > Class Diagram- Class Diagrams defines the basic building block of model namely types, classes and general material used to construct the full model. They describe the static structure of the system. They show existence of classes and their relationship which may be Generalization, Association, Aggregation, Composition or Dependency.
- > Collaboration Diagram-It describes interactions among objects in terms of messages. It emphasizes on the organization of the objects that participate in the interaction.
- > State Chart Diagram- It describes how the objects work. There are different parts of state like Name, Sub-states, State, Entry action, Exit action and Internal Activity.
- ➤ Component Diagram-It describes the organization of components, including source code, runtime code and executables. It gives the physical view of system in terms of implementation aspect. It constitutes the components, their interfaces and realizations and dependencies between components.
- > Deployment Diagram- It depicts physical resources in a system including nodes, components and connections.

At the end of the session a Case study was given in which the above mentioned concepts were covered.

Outcome of the Event:-

- > Faculties were able to practically apply software engineering methods, such as Object-oriented analysis and design methods with a clear emphasis on UML.
- > To analyze and design software systems, components to meet desired needs.
- > To use the graphical UML representation using tools, such as IBM's Rational Rose.

The session was conducted by Dr. Sheetal Punde. She described the various stresses facedby adults, she explained that our experience of what is considered "stressful" is created by our unique perceptions of what we encounter in life.






