### Vision

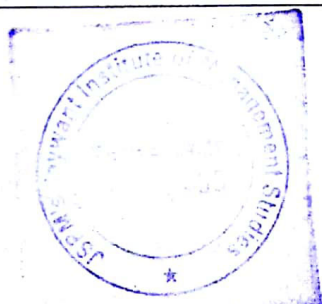
To develop, implement and sustain a quality culture aimed at overall quality improvement of the institute

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




